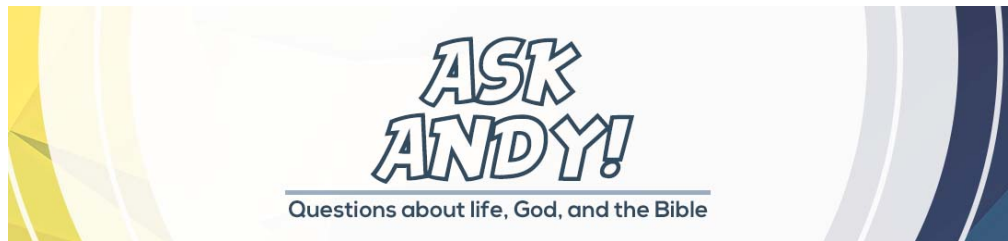

2. What do officers do and what do I do to become one?

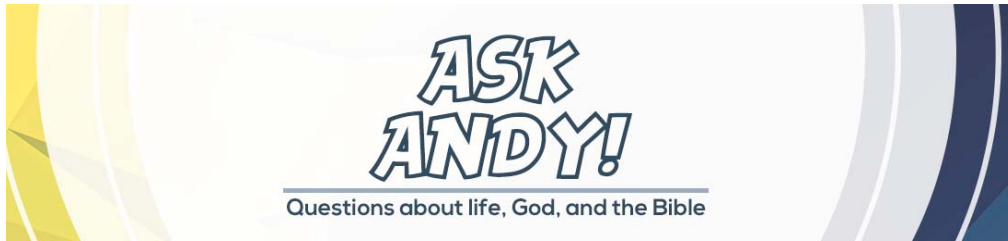
- What do officers do?

    - Availability



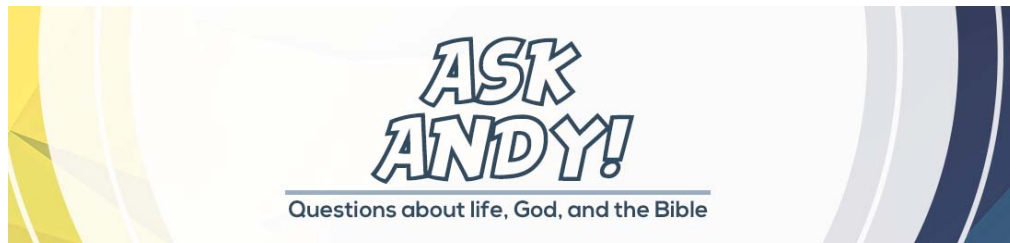
- Individual officer responsibilities

  - Everyone experiences loneliness.
    - Extroverts & introverts.
    - Married & single.
    - Young & old.



- Leaders & followers.
- Loneliness is not unique.
  - Elijah- 1 Kings 19:1-8
  - Woman at the well- John 4:1-42
  - Jesus- Matt. 26:36-46
- Is love the answer?
  - *Agape*- Love of God
  - *Storge*- parental love
  - *Phileo*- Friendship love
  - *Eros*- romantic love
- 3 principle ideas in love
  - Need love
  - Gift love
  - Appreciation love
- What is worship?
  - It's not merely a service.
  - It's a lifestyle (Phil. 3:3)
    - Thankfulness/Gratitude
    - Prayer
    - Song
    - Serving others
  - It's a life lived in admiration and thankfulness to God.
- In summary, loneliness must be replaced with worship
