Questions of Application

SPACEPETS (ch. 41)

- Sin to confess? Do I need to make restitution?
- Promise to claim? Is it a universal promise? Have I met the conditions?
- Attitude to change? Am I willing to work on a negative attitude and begin building toward a positive one
- Command to obey? Am I willing to do it not matter how I feel?
- Example to follow? Is it a positive example for me to copy or a negative one to avoid?
- Prayer to pray? Is there anything I need to pray back to God?
- Error to avoid? Is there any problem that I should be alert to, or reward of?
- Truth to believe? What new things can I learn about God the Father, Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit, or other biblical teachings?
- Something to praise God for? Is there something here I can be thankful for?

9 Questions to Ask (ch. 41)

- Is there an example to follow?

God fills His word with people because nothing helps the truth come alive the way people do.

- Compare your life to their life.
- Is there a sin to avoid?
- Is there a promise to claim?
- Is there a prayer to repeat?
 - What is there in these prayers that I need to be praying?
 - David's prayer of confession- Ps. 51
 - Hannah's prayer of thanksgiving- 1 Sam. 2:1-10
 - Jonah's prayer- Jonah 2
 - Mary's prayer- Luke 1:46-55
 - Paul's prayer- Eph. 3:14-21
 - Jesus' prayer in Gethsemane- Matt. 26:36-46; Mark 14:32-42; Luke 22:39-46
 - Disciples prayer- Matt. 6:5-15
- Is there a command to obey?
 - Application sections in Paul's epistles: Rom. 12-15; Gal. 5-6; Eph. 4-6; Col. 3-4
 - How to follow the will of God?
 - 95%- commands of Scripture
 - 5%- other truths
 - If you spend time attending to the commands, you won't have too much trouble dealing with the other 5%
- Is there a condition to meet? (John 15:7)
- Is there a verse to memorize?
- Is there an error to mark?
 - What doctrines/truths is this passage teaching
 - How does my thinking need to change?
- Is there a challenge to face?
